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### 2004 WULURA SHIRAZ

**Background:** Wulura Farms has developed a reputation as one of the premier grape growing estates in the Margaret River region. ‘Attention to detail’ is the mantra of Vineyard Manager Brad Harnett and anyone who visits the Yallingup property will see an immaculate vineyard always presented in pristine condition.

**Museum Release:** December 2009

**Style:** Full bodied dry red table wine

**Grape Varieties:** Shiraz 100%

**Vineyard Notes:** The 2004 vintage was a great vintage. The summer was long and cool and the grapes ripened beautifully. The wines will be long lived with great acids and great tannins.

**Tasting Notes:** Dark red with a crimson hue. Concentrated aromas of raspberry, plums, and Christmas cake with spice and pepper notes. Palate is concentrated and ripe with hints of sweet raspberry, plums, mint and stewed fruit balanced with cedary oak. Tannins are dense but still soft and velvety giving the wine great texture and length.

**Cellaring:** Enjoy now or cellar 3 – 4 years.
