



### THE STORY OF WULURA

The Wulura vineyard and farm nestles in countryside so pristine and beautiful you can understand the urge to bottle it. Situated at 888 Wildwood Road, Yallingup, it is a family-owned property of 650 hectares stretching towards Geographe Bay and the spectacular Indian Ocean coast.

Wulura Farms has developed a reputation as one of the finest wine-growing estates in the Margaret River region, with established vines planted in 1998.

“Attention to detail” is a way of life for Vineyard Manager, Brad Harnett, and anyone who visits will see an immaculate property tended and groomed to perfection.

The land has been farmed since the early days of European settlement. As well as the vineyard, Wulura Farms is also home to an olive grove and a herd of beef cattle surrounded by native eucalypt trees, wildflowers, kangaroos, birds and other inhabitants of the Australian bush.



### THE MARGARET RIVER WINE REGION

Margaret River is one of the premier wine-growing regions of the world. Tucked away in the south-west corner of Western Australia, the region boasts free-draining lateritic gravelly loam soils and a cool Mediterranean climate freshened by sea breezes from the Indian and Southern Oceans. This makes it the ideal place for growing grapes and crafting premium wines.

### OUR WINES

Wulura grows a range of high quality grapes including shiraz, cabernet sauvignon, merlot, chardonnay, chenin blanc, semillon and sauvignon blanc. These are handcrafted into a selection of premium red and white wines.

**Museum Release:** December 2009

**Style:** Full bodied dry red table wine

**Grape Varieties:** A blend of cabernet sauvignon, cabernet franc, malbec, petite verdot and merlot

**Vineyard Notes:** The 2004 vintage was a great vintage. The summer was long and cool and the grapes ripened beautifully. The wines will be long lived with great acids and great tannins.

**Tasting Notes:** Aromas of cigar box and violets and the recognisable aroma of good cabernet. Palate has amazing density and subtlety. Nuances of oak, sweet fruit and berries. Long silky tannins, a very fine wine aging beautifully and will continue to improve over the next few years.

**Cellaring:** Enjoy now or cellar 3 – 4 years.



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
